• EDGE:

Enhancing Development of Global Entrepreneur Program is funded by Japanese government, MEXT*


Purpose:

to enhance activities, such as generating entrepreneurial ventures, developing human resources and making these activities sustainable with setting up "Innovation eco-system"

What is "Keio" EDGE program?


- By learning innovative thinking approaches, the participants would convert their strength and mindset to interdisciplinary approach capability for innovators in global context
- 2) Course work is a structured combination of design thinking, systems thinking, and business synthesis thinking with learning both mindset and tool set
- 3) Project work is a PBL curriculum which will pursue a new value proposition and its implementation
